**You will officiate a minimum of 5 games per session that you register for!**

**Session 1** registration from 3:00 – 3:45 p.m. on Friday  
Pre-Camp meeting Friday 4:00 p.m. to 5:45 p.m.  
Games Friday 7:00 p.m. to Saturday 3:30 p.m.  
**Be prepared to stay at camp for games until 3:30 on Saturday**

**Session 2** registration from 12:15 – 1:00 p.m. on Saturday  
Pre-Camp meeting Saturday 1:15 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.  
Games Saturday 3:30 p.m. to Sunday 12:30 p.m.  
**Be prepared to stay at camp for games until 12:30 on Sunday**
